The contributors to this volume explore these issues across three theoretical and conceptual dimensions: * reconceptualizing how we think about intergroup attitudes * examining motivations and expectations across group boundaries * promoting closeness and inclusion in cross-group relationships The book's final grouping of chapters applies these concepts to forgiveness, reparation, and reconciliation among different ethnopolitical groups in postconflict societies. Specific case studies include Arab-Israeli relations and post-Pinochet Chile.
