

The convivial drinking of ale is referred to, aspects of military fort building, commerce between settlements, and the life in the countryside around the Euphrates river. The theme of strong friendship and the bonds therein are a vivid theme in the Gilgamesh epic, retaining their power and substance thousands of years after being committed to stone.
